

End of the Year One Pager Project

A one-pager is a collage of illustrations and written analyses on one page that make up an aesthetically pleasing and detailed interpretation of a subject or piece of literature.

Directions:

Imaginatively blend your thoughts and ideas with colorful images based on this school year, this summer, and next school year. You should spend at least thirty minutes brainstorming ideas before you begin decorating your page. Use a standard size piece of blank paper (8.5 x 11) or you may use a template provided for you.

Below is a list of what should be included on your page:

- Include your first and last name.
- Include four or more illustrations/graphic images.
- Include three words that describe your experience this school year.
- Describe your favorite memory from this year.
- Explain one thing you are looking forward to *next year*.
- Describe two goals or plans you have for this summer.
- List one song that you loved this year.
- Include one piece of advice you have for next year's students.
- Include one thing you will miss about this school year OR one thing you have learned.
- You must fill the entire page.
- Your page must be colored.

Grading Rubric

Overall Appearance	Your page is detailed and neat. Images are clear and text is easy to read. The overall appearance is aesthetically pleasing.	10 Points
Creativity	You carefully choose images and text that resonate with your personality and are a meaningful reflection of your emotions, dreams, and interests. The overall presentation highlights your creativity.	10 Points
Information	You include all the components required in the directions. Your answers are genuine, honest, and appropriate.	10 Points
Graphics	You choose illustrations that are relevant. The graphic elements are distinct, colored, and incorporated seamlessly into the work.	10 Points
