## One Pager Project

A one pager is a collage of illustrations and written analyses on one page that make up an aesthetically pleasing and detailed interpretation of a subject or piece of literature.

### Directions:

Share your unique understanding of the text on one page by imaginatively blending your written ideas with colorful images from the story. You should spend at least thirty minutes reading and/or brainstorming ideas before you begin decorating your page. Use a standard size piece of blank paper (8.5 x 11) or you may use a template provided for you.

### Below is a list of what should be included on your page:

- Include the title of the novel and the author's name.
- Include one theme from the novel and explain how the author incorporates this message into the plot.
- Illustrate four images that are related to the plot somehow.
- In 1-3 sentences, write a brief summary of the book.
- Include one quote from the novel.
- Describe an example of conflict from the story (internal or external).
- Choose two or more of the following literary elements to incorporate into your project using specific examples from the novel: setting, motif, point of view, foreshadowing, mood, tone, irony, characterization, symbolism, figurative language, or imagery.
- You must fill the entire page.
- Your page must be colored.

### Grading Rubric

Overall Appearance	Your page is detailed and neat. Images are clear and text is easy to read. The overall appearance is creative and aesthetically pleasing.	10 Points
Information	Your summary, explanations, and references are accurate and you include all the components required in the directions.	10 Points
Analysis	You show you understand the literature through your explanation and use of examples/quotations from the text.	10 Points
Plot References	The analysis of literary elements are all insightful and accurate. They depict important ideas from the story.	10 Points
Graphics	You choose illustrations that highlight important parts of the novel. The graphic elements are neat, colored, and are incorporated seamlessly into the work.	10 Points

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

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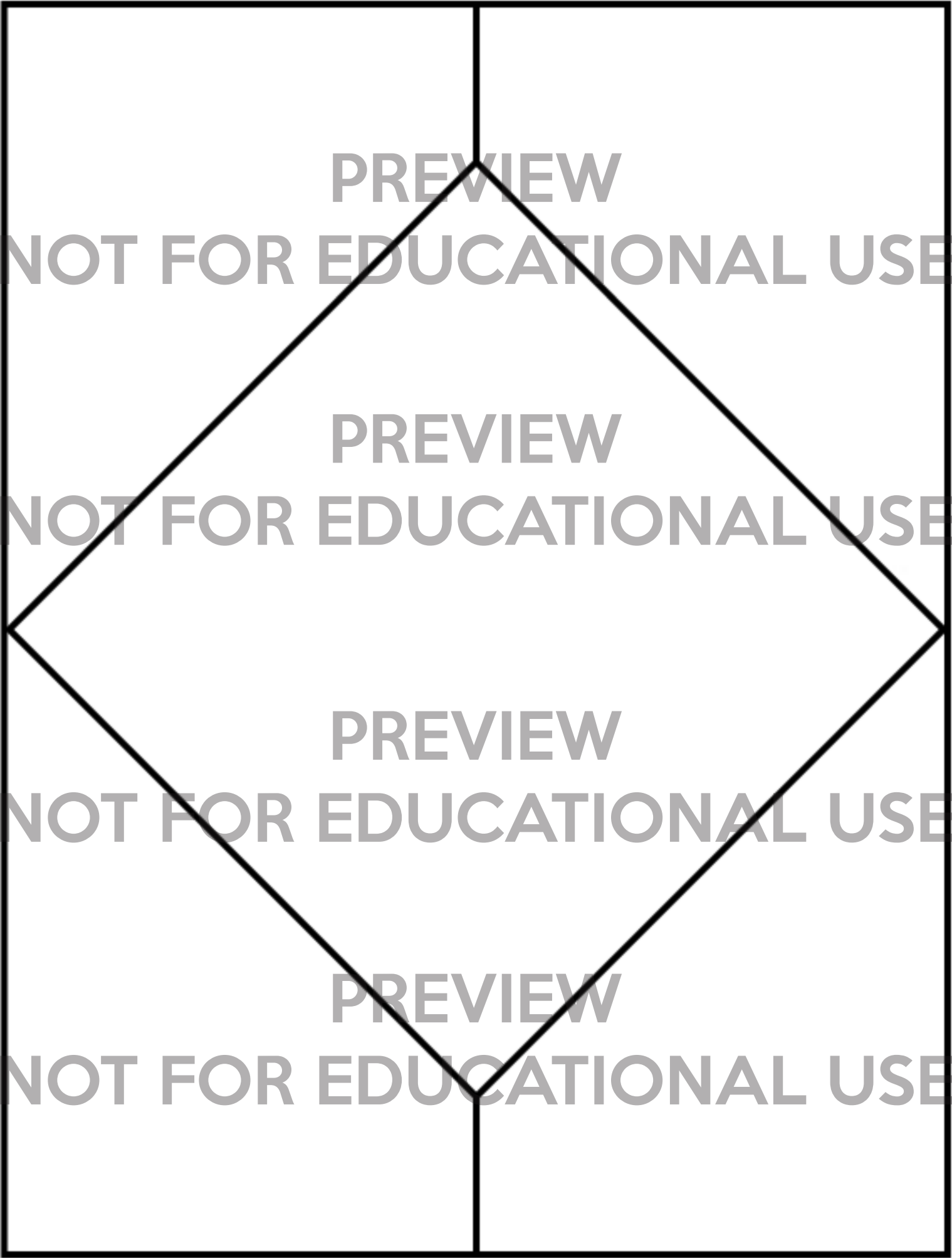
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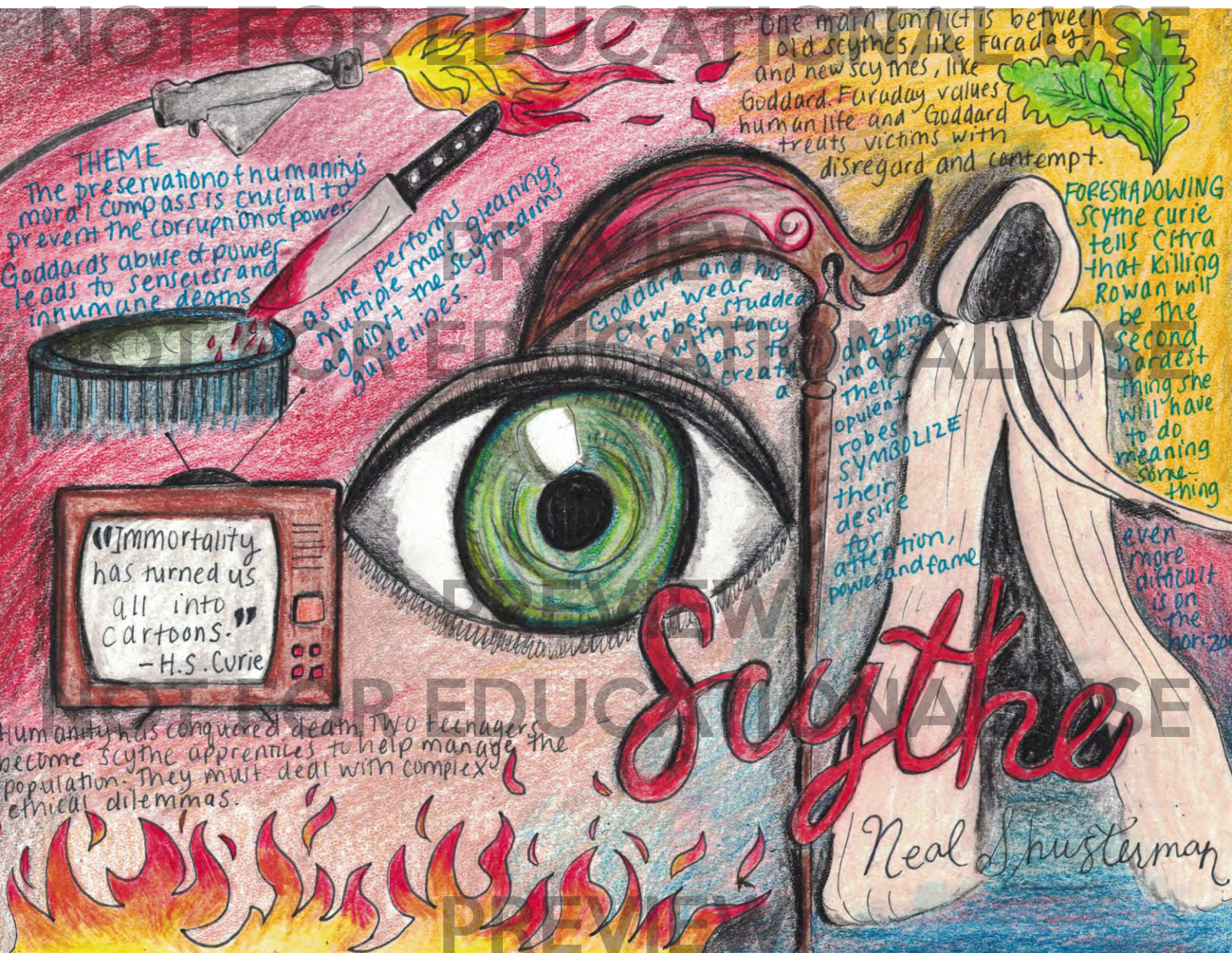
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
