3. Veterans Day was originally referred to as what name? **Armistice Day**

4. What year did November 11th become a national holiday? **1938**

5. How is Veterans Day different than Memorial Day? **Memorial Day pays tribute to those who have died while serving their country, whereas Veterans Day gives thanks to all those who have served.**

6. In 1954, which president changed the holiday's name to Veterans Day? **Dwight D. Eisenhower**

7. Veterans Day commemorates veterans of which war? **ALL**

8. Arlington Cemetery is the home to the graves of how many people? **Over 400,000**
