Below is a list of what should be included on your page:


- Include the full name of the person you research.

- · Include two or more quotations from the person you are studying.
- Include three or more words that describe the person's personality.
- Include three or more illustrations/graphic images that symbolize the person's life.
- Include four or more facts about the person that you've learned about.
- You must fill the entire page. You don't want a lot of empty space (if any).
- Your page must be colored.

Grading Rubric:

Overall Appearance	Your page is detailed and neat. Images are clear and text is easy to read. The overall appearance is creative and aesthetically pleasing.	10 Points
Information	Your work shows you have done thorough research for the project. Your facts are accurate and relevant.	10 Points
Quotations	The quotations you chose are both meaningful and accurate. They depict the person's impact on society and were chosen carefully.	10 Points
Graphics	You chose illustrations that highlight important parts of the person's life. The graphic elements are neat, colored, and are incorporated seamlessly into the work.	10 Points






